DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES: Preparation of the Annual Program

Consistent with the duties of the Past President of the Academy, a program for the 2009 meeting was developed. The theme of the program is “Kinesiology in Higher Education: Thriving or Surviving” to be held October 1-3 in San Diego, CA (Catamaran Resort). An outstanding group of presenters has agreed to present papers focusing on various topics, including diversity and demographics, accreditation and program review, proposed changes and implications for health reform, and an international example of program cooperation (C. Vendien Lecture). Dr. Timothy White (Fellow, # 344, President of the University of California at Riverside, will serve as the keynote Thursday evening speaker. The last session on Saturday will be an update on efforts by the American Kinesiology Association to support academic departments and colleges.
